



ARISE Ministry empowers individuals involved in the sex trade to reclaim hope in their lives. Through providing outreach, case management, and pastoral care; helping relationships are established, hope is fostered, and futures are reclaimed.

**Outreach:**

ARISE provides street level outreach on a weekly basis to individuals working on the prostitution strolls. Through outreach we seek to build relationships, offer relief, and provide support.

**Case Management Program:**

ARISE offers a goal-oriented, one-on-one case management program for those who are or who have been involved in the sex trade. The case management program works with each participant on the goals they identify and is individualized. Weekly meetings include a check-in, life skills, counselling and goal setting.

**Self-Defence Program:**

ARISE offers a free women's self-defence program in partnership with a local martial arts academy.

**Pastoral Care:**

ARISE offers chaplaincy and spiritual care to the community through accompaniment, advocacy, hospital and jail visits.
